

## COMPETITION GUIDELINES\*

1. Entry is open to all who are not currently employed by the Seventh-day Adventist Church.
2. You can submit as many entries as you like.
3. Competition closes on **Friday 30th November 2018** (the “Closing Date”).
4. Even if your devotion is not shortlisted, it may still be selected for broadcast, if this is the case you will be eligible for a £10 prize
5. To enter please email your devotion(s) to [julian@adventistradio.london](mailto:julian@adventistradio.london) before the Closing Date. Your email must contain your entry, name, age, home address, email address and, telephone number.
6. Your Devotion must be at least 500 words long but no longer than 800 words. Entries must be typed in English only. Your entry must be written in the body of the email only, no attachments will be read.
7. Entries must be the original work of the entrant and not previously published anywhere else.
8. Entries must be in line with the Ethics, Theology and Teachings of the Seventh-day Adventist Church
9. All valid entries received before the Closing Date will be Short-listed by the ARL team who will use the following Judging Criteria.
  - a. Christ-centredness
  - b. Compelling Content
  - c. Clarity
  - d. Relevance
  - e. Storytelling
10. The shortlists will consist of three entries per category, short-listed entries will receive an award and £20 each.
11. The final decision concerning winning entries will be made by an expert panel
12. Entrants will retain copyright in their submitted entries, however, by entering, all entrants licence The Seventh-day Adventist Church, Adventist World Radio and, Adventist Radio London, a worldwide royalty-free perpetual licence to edit, publish and use each entry in any and all media (including print, online and, radio broadcast) for publicity and news purposes relating to this competition.
